


DWQAR Reporting Webform Hinekorako Guide

This documentation will support suppliers in submitting their Drinking Water Quality Assurance Rules (the Rules) Reporting through the webform on the Hinekōrako portal. Submitting reporting through this webform is currently only available to suppliers reporting at level 1 or 2. If you report against level 3 rules, you will need to do so through either an excel upload or an API upload. Each person who will report using API requires a personal API key. This key is generated from the Reporting section in the Hinekōrako supplier portal.

We are not currently able to receive samples or monitoring results through the webform, we are looking into incorporating this in a future update.


Accessing the Rules Reporting Webform

Note that some rules have a Not Applicable option where the rule is not always required. Select Not Applicable only when the situation the rule applies to has not occurred. For example, you were not required to take any chlorine samples under rule T2.4.
